The fruit for our 2008 Sauvignon Blanc was sourced from the cool Arroyo Seco appellation in the Salinas Valley of Monterey County.

Delicate and feminine in style our 2008 Sauvignon Blanc wine has a distinct melon aroma, coupled with classic varietal flavors of grapefruit and sweet pea at its core. We added 20% of our Arroyo Seco Pinot Grigio to the blend to lend some high-toned fruity notes, as well as a distinct lavender and floral component. This Sauvignon Blanc pairs beautifully with simply prepared seafood and chicken dishes as well as Thai style Asian cuisine.
